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
CODE OF CONDUCT



BIPOC


"Systemic" here means that the core racist realities are manifested in each of society's major parts, or systems

The wealth gap is a disparity in the wealth or income of individuals, populations, or nations. It can also be referred to as income inequality, wealth disparity, or wealth and income differences.

WEALTH GAP Black, Indigenous, and people of color. This acronym specifically calls attention to the unique experiences of Black and Indigenous folks.

the situation in which all people or groups are given access to the correct number and types of resources for them so as to achieve equal results; differs from equality, which focuses on the equal distribution of resources rather than equal results


